When activated, the bug emits an 85 decibel "beep" until the child is located and the adult turns off the device.

The Giggle Bug concept was created by Julianne Wallace- mother of four and wife of Intelent Technologies' CEO, Barry Wallace. After a couple of frightening incidents with their youngest child who tended to wander off in public places, she realized the great need for this type of product in the consumer marketplace.

"From personal experience we know what it feels like when you look down and realize your child has wandered away from you," says Intelent Technologies' founder and CEO, Barry Wallace. "That feeling of sheer panic convinced us that there needs to be a way for parents/care-givers to quickly locate their child in this type of situation. Our goal is to create an effective, user-friendly and affordable device that will provide a little peace of mind."
